SCHOOL SUPPLY COLLECTION RECAP

The Community Care Team's 12th Annual School Supply Collection wrapped up this week. 100 sets of school supplies were delivered to Wyland Elementary and Ritenour Middle School Monday morning. The principals, guidance counselors, social workers and staff were thrilled to receive the supplies. Thanks to your generosity every year, we're able to provide supplies to students who just can't afford the items. We were told that as parents call throughout the summer, the staff is relieved to tell them their child will have supplies the first day of school. We were also informed that the schools try to keep a number of our bags on hand for the many new students who arrive throughout the year who have no supplies. Our supplies are a lifesaver for the teachers and students who need the supplies ASAP to get the new students off to a good start. Each bag of supplies includes a note letting the student know the supplies came from Immanuel Lutheran Church.

This year, the school supplies were bought with \$1,400 of Walmart gift cards that we purchased through the PSCE Scrip program, with \$42 going back to PSCE. We also donated the extra, leftover supplies to Immanuel Day School.

This collection couldn't happen without our Immanuel members' support year after year. Thank you so much! Special thanks to Diane Tallyn for coordinating the collection and to the Krenning Family (Dan, Katie, Ella and Luke) and John Hough for delivering the supplies!
