Nurses for Newborns provides a safety net for families most at-risk in order to prevent infant mortality, child abuse and neglect by providing in-home nursing visits which promote healthcare, education, and positive parenting skills.

They provide a wide variety of vital services depending on the specific need of the family and the newborn. This allows us to tailor our visits to assist with the various risk factors including poverty, depression, violence, education and medically fragile babies.

In addition to medical care, they assist families whenever possible with donated materials needed for safe care, such as diapers, formula, baby food, clothing, bedding, and Pack 'n Plays. We welcome hundreds of volunteers each year who help us manage the logistics of this work.
